AS HURRICANE LANE APPROACHES**

(Honolulu, Hawai'i) August 24, 2018 – To ensure the safety of our employees, Island Energy Services (IES), Hawai'i's Texaco-brand licensee, will close seven (7) company-owned O`ahu Texaco service stations at 8 a.m., today, Friday, August 24, in response to impending inclement weather caused by Hurricane Lane.

Stations will reopen to serve the community only when it is safe to do so, and after appropriate hazard assessments have been conducted.

- Stadium Texaco (4561 Salt Lake Blvd.)
