Island Energy Services Raises \$100,000 for American Red Cross of Hawai'i Through a Statewide Round Up Campaign at its Company-Owned Texaco Locations

WAIĀKEA, Hawai'i (June 25, 2026) Island Energy Services, LLC (IES), the exclusive licensee of the Texaco brand in Hawai'i, announced the successful completion of its 2026 Red Cross Round Up Campaign, which generated a total of \$100,000 in support of the American Red Cross Hawai'i Chapter.

The campaign, held from March through April 2026 in recognition of Red Cross Month in Hawai'i, gave Texaco customers the opportunity to round up their purchases and make direct donations at checkout. Thirty Texaco stations and two franchisees participated in the statewide effort. In response to severe Kona Low storms that impacted communities across the state during the campaign period, IES increased its initial matching pledge amount from \$20,000 to \$50,000.

To recognize the success of the campaign, IES and representatives of the American Red Cross Hawai'i Chapter gathered at Waiākea Texaco in Hilo, the top fundraising Texaco location during the campaign. Waiākea Texaco raised nearly \$7,500.00, the highest amount among participating stations.

"We are incredibly grateful to our Texaco customers, employees, franchisees, and station teams across the state for helping us reach this important goal," said Jon Mauer, CEO of Island Energy Services. "This campaign reflects the generosity of Hawai'i's communities and the strength of local partnerships. We are proud to support the American Red Cross Hawai'i Chapter and the critical work it does for families and communities in times of need."

The top three fundraising locations were all in Neighbor Island communities: Waiākea Texaco in Hilo, Hawai'i; Kōloa Town Texaco in Kōloa, Kaua'i; and Uptown Texaco in Wailuku, Maui.

"At the American Red Cross Hawai'i Chapter, we rely on strong community partners like Island Energy Services, through its Texaco retail locations, to help us carry out our mission," said Molly Schmidt, Regional Chief Executive Officer for the American Red Cross Pacific Islands Region.
